Evening Activities

You have the option of leading your own evening program for the Participants or Hazen Staff would be happy to do it for you. Below are some suggestions for evening programs that the Hazen staff have brainstormed and have had some success with in the past:

‘Rock Quiz’ – the entire group is split into two teams, each sitting in half of the dining hall. A number of different competitions and quiz are carried out involving volunteers from each team as well as the team as whole. It may be a tic-tac-toe competition, but in order to put a piece on the board you have to answer a question, or maybe you have to be the first person to stand up that is wearing a red shirt – it could be anything!

Campfire – Hazen Staff will encourage the Participants throughout the day to come up with skits and songs that can be performed at the campfire. Of course our staff are no strangers to singing a few songs and participating in a couple of skits as well!

Movie night – we could set up a TV and video for your use, if you would like to bring your own suitable movie.

Oscar night – split up in to groups of 6-8, each group has to choose either a scene from a movie that they have to practice and then perform to the entire group, or a complete movie that they have to get the story across in a 3 minute skit. Oscars are awarded based on Best Action Scene, Best Musical, Best Actor, Best Comedy, etc.

Carnival night – Our dining hall is transformed with all the fun of the fair. Lots of different stalls with various games and activities are set up so guest can choose where they’d like to spend their time. If you’re luck their may even be some popcorn floating around....
